


Guidelines for opening post graduate course at the Masters level in private universities

- 1) The Accreditation and Education Committee of the Pharmacy Council of Bangladesh (PCB) shall visit any university intending to start Masters program to evaluate the existing resources and other facilities before making any recommendation to the University Grants Commission (UGC) for final approval of the said program.
- 2) The University shall have to pay a sum of Tk. 30000/- (Thirty thousand) to the PCB as pre-approval visit fee.
- 3) The PCB will recommend a university to the University Grants Commission (UGC) to start post graduate course(s) at the Masters level upon consideration ^{of} the following requirements:
 - a) **Bachelor of Pharmacy Program:**

A university may be allowed to start Masters program in Pharmacy, if the B. Pharm. program of that university is already accredited by the PCB.



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b) Eligibility for admission:

Students seeking admission to the Masters program (M. Pharm., M.S., M. Pharm. in Tech., etc) MUST have Bachelor of Pharmacy degree from a government & UGC recongnized university and which is accredited by the Pharmacy Council of Bangladesh

c) Faculty members:


I) The department shall have adequate number of teachers having M. Phil/Ph.D. degree in pharmaceutical sciences commensurate with the Masters program. For example, department intending to start Master of Pharmaceutical Technology program should have at least ONE faculty memembr with M. Phil/Ph.D. degree in the relevent field.

II) The teachers shall have the UGC approved qualifications and teaching experience.

d) Laboratory facilities:

There shall be adequate number of research laboratories equipped with necessary equipments, instruments, glasswares and accessories.




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
